





Welcome to Our Space!

If you have registered with an IAF mentor or have joined the Prince's Trust Team programme, you will be invited to join Our Space, a virtual safe space run by and for young people across Nottinghamshire. This private virtual network allows you to connect with others, make plans, access support and shape IAF services for future generations.



1> Your mentor will text you a link to the Our Space community. If you are already signed up with a Discord account, click the + icon on the left side bar to add a new server. On the 'Create your server' pop up, click the Join a Server button.




Enter the URL given by your mentor in the next box and click the Join Server button.

If you are not already signed up to the Discord platform, you can create a free account at <u>discord.com</u> before following the steps above.








2> When you have joined the Our Space server, you will be able to access welcome information, our community guidelines, and for new users a handy #how-to-use channel, please read this quick-start information to help us keep our community safe, inclusive and accessible for all.



3> If you're happy with everything you've read and want to access the full server, you'll need to submit an application through the # verification-chat channel. To start this process. click into the channel and type /apply.














3> The application bot will ask you 4 questions:

Your full name (as they appear on your IAF registration form)

Your date of birth

Who referred you (Mentors/Team Leaders Name)

Your location (Mansfield, Worksop or Nottingham City).

Answer the questions before clicking the button. Applications are reviewed daily by IAF staff and incomplete applications will be rejected.



Why do I need to do all this?

Throughout the design and development of this platform, young people have repeatedly told us that Our Space must be a closed, private group and shared their experiences and concerns about cyber-bullying. This human verification of new users, against IAF's internal records, ensures the platform remains accessible to only those accessing our programmes.



What can I do if my application is rejected?

Applications to join the server will typically be rejected if the details given do not match your IAF registration form or the application is incomplete.


